

Faith and Family Night Idea: Make family meal time important this month. Choose one night out of each week this month to set aside as a faith and family night. Take turns allowing one member of the family to “plan” the dinner. Let that child or parent choose what you will eat for dinner and dessert and have that person be in charge of choosing and telling a Bible Story during dinner. They can prepare ahead of time by reading the story and learning it well enough to tell it themselves or they can read the story to the family from the Bible or a Storybook Bible! Talk as a family about what God teaches us in the story you heard. Seek to engage in meaningful conversation with your family. Quality time in God’s word is essential to a family on Mission with Christ!

Hey Parents. Let me say Happy Easter to you. As you as a family have celebrated the fun of I want to encourage you to also share the resurrection story of Jesus with your kids. For a devotion this morning during dinner, read Luke 23:39-43. This is the story of the 2 thieves on the cross beside Jesus. Talk about what it takes to truly be a follower of Jesus. Two things happen in this story. The believing thief recognizes his own sin (v. 41) and then he puts his faith in Jesus as the true Messiah (v. 42). This is a great way to share what it takes to be a Christian; faith in Jesus and repentance of our sins. Thank you for discipling your children at home. There is not a more important thing you can do.
