
Wednesday night study on why we can trust the Bible.

Hello again, church family!

It's hard to believe that it's already November! This fall has been full of ministry, and we have seen the Lord do incredible things- both here at Cornerstone and in Pampa as a whole. The Celebration of Hope Crusade was a tremendous success, with many souls saved for the Kingdom, but I am just as excited by the response to our New Believer classes, where we have been faithful to disciple these baby Christians and help them grow into their new faith. For the last 6 weeks, we have studied God's plan for Believers- that HE is the assurance of our salvation; that He designed us for community, not isolation; that He has given us His Holy Spirit as a constant comforter and guide; and that He desires relationship with us through His Word and prayer.

It would be so easy now, on the tail end of this class and crusade, to say that it is time to rest and cruise our way through the holidays, but ministry never stops. There are still many lost folks who desperately need Jesus in our community, and we need to be His hands and feet in taking the Gospel to them. We certainly wouldn't be the first believers to tire and to flag in our efforts to share the good news. Paul wrote in two separate letters (Galatians 6:9 and II Thessalonians 3:13), "Let us not grow weary of doing good," because the believers in Galatia and Thessalonica felt tired and exhausted doing the things the Lord called them to do. He continues in Galatians with the reason why we must be unflagging in our work for Christ; "for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."

There is a harvest in the fields. We have planted, the Lord has cultivated, now we must be faithful to reap. I encourage you to find someone TODAY with whom you can be Christ's hands and feet. Share the gospel with someone at the grocery store. Find a baby Christian in need of time with mature believers. Volunteer to help with TeamKids, or the nursery, or an adult Sunday School class. Find a way to be Christ to someone today- don't grow tired of good works, because there is a harvest coming.


