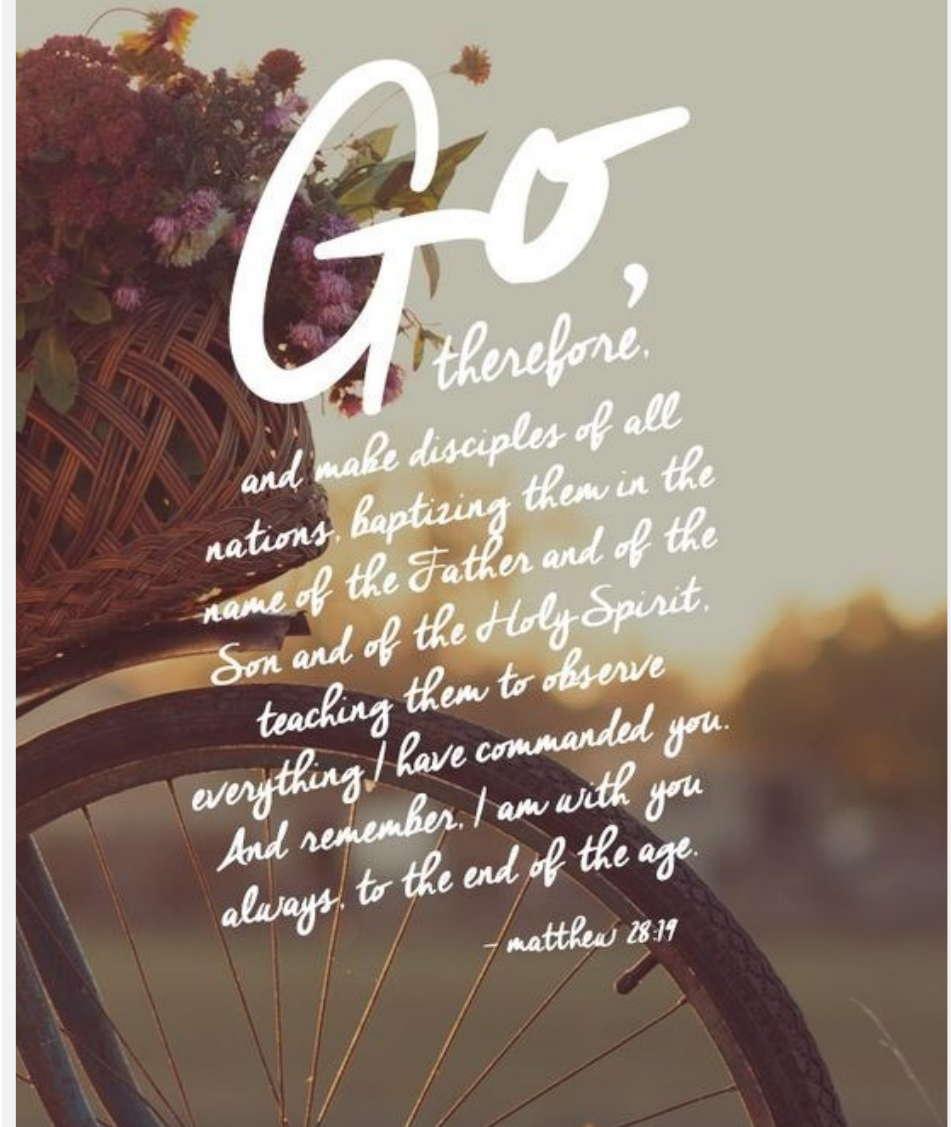

HOW CAN WE GIVE WHEN THE CULTURE SAYS GET

Great Reasons to Give

The most obvious reason to give is that God commanded us to give throughout the Old and New Testaments.

1) Giving is an external expression and commitment of our obedience and willingness to serve God.

*"Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offering." **Malachi 3:8***

*"But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves." **James 1:22***

2) Giving demonstrates that we acknowledge that God owns everything and has made us stewards of "our" possessions.

Giving shows that God, not gain, is first in our lives.

"The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts."

Haggai 2:8

*"No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon." **Matthew 6:24***

3) Giving demonstrates a grateful heart. We received bountifully from the Lord, and we return the first and the best to the source of the bounty.

"Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver."

2 Corinthians 9:7

4) Giving prospers the ministry for the Lord in the local church. As the church prospers, more souls are saved, more saints are in the word, more churches are started, and more missionaries are sent out.

*"Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness." **Romans 12:8***
