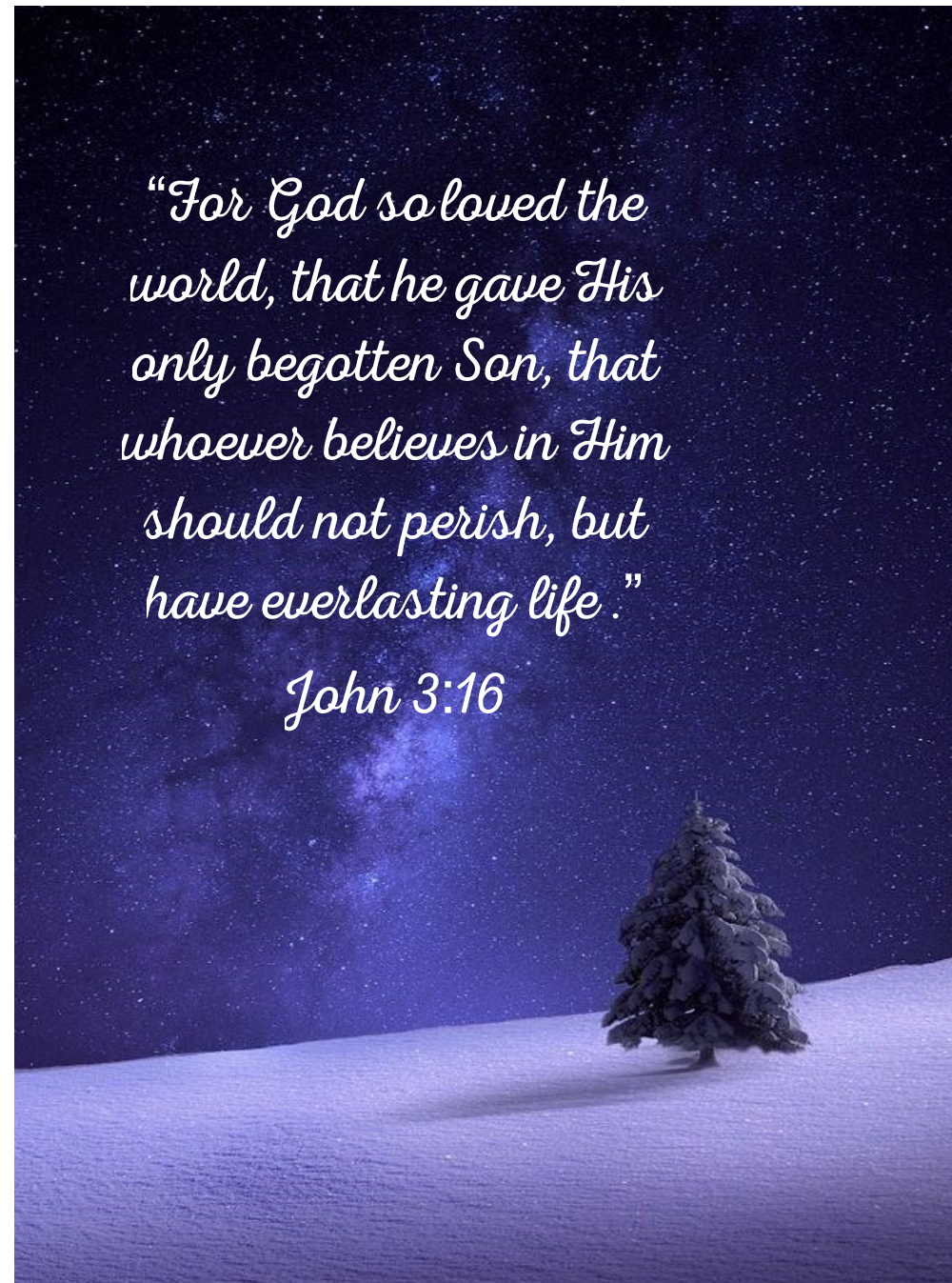

## **WHAT IS THE MAIN MOTIVATION FOR CHRISTMAS?**

***The MESSIAH or MONEY***

Christmas is typically the largest economic stimulus for many nations around the world as sales increase dramatically in almost all retail areas. The United States' retail industry generated over three trillion U.S. dollars during the holidays in 2013. The Christmas tree is an integral part of the holiday shopping season. About 26 million real Christmas trees were purchased in the United States and cost, on average, about \$50.82 U.S. dollars in 2015. These holiday sales reflected about 19.2% of the retail industries total sales that year. Just over 768 thousand employees are hired throughout the United States to compensate for the holiday rush. Shoppers around the country say they are planning to spend an average of \$929 for gifts this holiday season. It is the first time planned gift spending exceeds \$900 since 2006.
