“For men shall be lovers of their own selves...” 2 Tim 3:2

- Reluctant to sacrifice my time to minister to the needs of others.
- Seeking “the best”, “the first”, “the most” for myself.
- Expecting others to understand and accept me as I am, while being impatient with the failures of others.
- Insisting on my right to be happy and fulfilled.

Love of Pleasure

“...Lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God.” 2 Tim 3:4

- More interested in talking about sports, hobbies, or television programs than about the Lord.
- More interested in planning a vacation than seeking out opportunities to grow spiritually and minister to others.
- Devoting more time, money, and effort to a hobby than to spiritually disciplining the lives of my children.
- Enjoying spending hours watching television, movies, and videos, but getting bored listening to someone teach the Word of God.
- Greater appetite for physical food than for the spiritual meat of God’s Word.
- More excited about attending a church dinner than a prayer meeting.
- Preferring sports activities, events, or programs over spiritual exercise in the Word and prayer.
- Neglecting or procrastinating difficult distasteful responsibilities.
- Spending more time reading secular magazines, books, or newspapers than reading and studying the Word of God.
- Enjoying parties and jokes more than serious fellowship and interaction about spiritual matters.
