**There's A Lot In That "Word"!**

**Logos** is from the root **leg**, appearing in **legeo**, the primitive meaning of which is to lay: then, to pick out, gather, pick up: hence to gather or put words together, and so, to speak. Hence **logos** is, first of all, a collecting or collection both of things in the mind, and of words by which they are expressed. It therefore signifies both the outward form by which the inward thought is expressed, and the inward thought itself, {compare: the Latin oratio and ratio and the Italian ragionare, "to think" and "to speak."} *Vincent's Word Studies*, by Marvin R. Vincent, [1886], at sacred-texts.com

(Quakers bump up to this when in business they have been known to say "Friend, \_\_\_ speaks my mind" meaning the previous person expressed well what was in my heart also.)
