**Live as Servants of God**

*<sup>11</sup> Beloved, I beseech you as aliens and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh that wage war against your soul. <sup>12</sup> Maintain good conduct among the Gentiles, so that in case they speak against you as wrongdoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation. <sup>13</sup> Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, <sup>14</sup> or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do wrong and to praise those who do right. <sup>15</sup> **For it is God's will that by doing right you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish men.** <sup>16</sup> Live as free men, yet without using your freedom as a pretext for evil; but live as servants of God. <sup>17</sup> Honor all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the emperor. 1 Peter 2*
