What was a centurion?

Definition: A centurion was an officer in the army of ancient Rome. They got their name because they commanded 100 men (*centuria* = 100 in Latin). Centurions were hardened, experienced soldiers, skilled at killing. Most were enlisted men promoted through the ranks after 15 to 20 years of service.

A number of Roman centurions are mentioned in the [New Testament](#), including one who came to [Jesus Christ](#) for help when his servant was paralyzed and in pain. That man's faith in Christ was so strong that Jesus healed the servant from a great distance ([Matthew 8:5-13](#)). <http://christianity.about.com/od/glossary/a/Centurion.htm>
