1. My son is **SOMETHING SPECIAL**

*Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,  
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6*

<sup>18</sup> *No one has ever seen God, but the one and only  
Son, who is himself God John 1*

<sup>6</sup> *Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and  
the life. No one comes to the Father except through  
me. John 14*

<sup>16</sup> *For in him all things were created: things in heaven  
and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones  
or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have  
been created through him and for him. <sup>17</sup> He is before  
all things, and in him all things hold together.  
Colossians 1*

2. My son could do **SOMETHING SPECIAL**
