

Missions Trip Opportunity for Churches in the West Chowan Baptist Association!

Are you looking for new missions trip opportunities right here in North Carolina? If so, Avery County Habitat for Humanity is the right choice for you!

- ◆ Avery County Habitat for Humanity offers missions trip opportunities for groups of any size and any skill level to help build homes for families in need here in the mountains of North Carolina. Volunteers ages 16+ can use power tools and be anywhere on jobsite, and we do have other tasks that volunteers under the age of 16 can do.
- ◆ Our Construction Manager stays onsite with volunteer groups to offer guidance and leadership every step of the way, and our Volunteer Coordinator works closely with groups to plan out time on and off the jobsite.
- ◆ Groups have the option of renting out the Gilmer Community Center, an overnight accommodations building that can sleep up to 38 people in bunks, a commercial kitchen, a large living and dining space with comfortable seating, separate male and female bathrooms and shower areas, and outdoor space perfect for enjoying the cool mountain air. The cost to rent out the Gilmer Center is \$175/per person/per week. Discounted price available for shorter stays.
- ◆ Enjoy time off the jobsite with free recreational activities such as guided hike tours and admission into Grandfather Mountain State Park. Some meals can be coordinated with local volunteers as well to cut back on costs.
