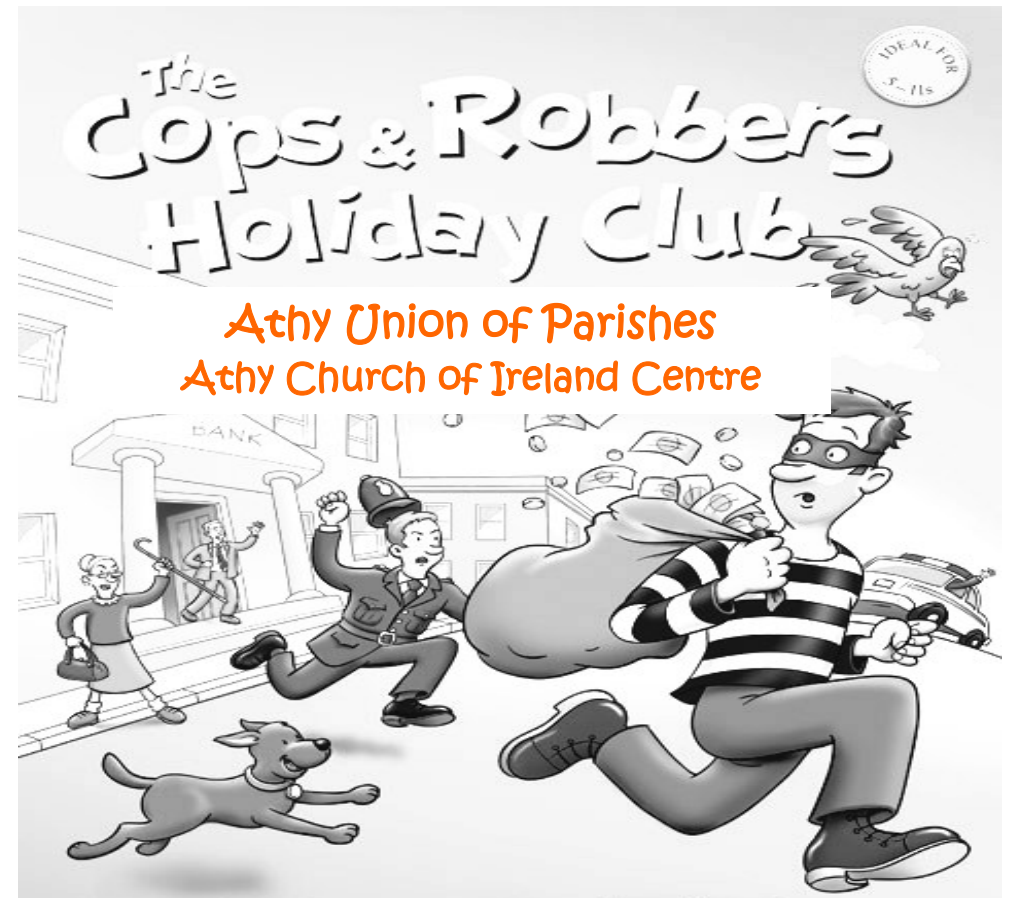

Who runs the Holiday Club?

The Holiday Club is being run by your local Church of Ireland Parish, with helpers coming from other parishes, and complies with Safeguarding Trust, the Church of Ireland's code of practice for working with children.

What happens at the club?
