

REGATHERING IS HERE!

Thanks to guidance from Bishop Jose and the Governor, we are now able to regather indoors with limits. The information below outlines how this initial trial will work. Necessary adjustments may be made along the way to ensure our success. Let's all do our part to keep everyone safe!

- Services are limited to 25 people (including those who serve))
- Assigned seating
- Masks & social distancing are required at all times
- Enter only through the rear doors of the main worship space (nearest the rectory)
- After the service we must exit through the same doors back rows first working our way forward
- No building tours at this time
- Responsible outside visiting in the Dogwood Chapel is available
- Sadly, you must refrain from singing in the church at this time
