WHAT TO BRING

****Ponderosa is located at an elevation of 7600+ ft with varying temperatures.**

- Backpack or duffel bag for all camper's gear (they will get a string backpack for carrying around light things during camp)
- Casual, layered clothes for 3 days and 3 nights
- Tennis shoes w/ closed toe and heel
- Jacket/sweatshirt (nights are chilly and daytime as well if it's raining)
- Set of "grubbies" (clothes that can get dirty, muddy, etc.)
- Plastic bags for wet/dirty clothes
- Towels, washcloth for showering
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, deodorant and other necessary toiletries
- Pillow/Sleeping bag or twin-size bedding
- Chapstick (it's very dry)
- Sunscreen
- Ball cap or other sun blocking hat
- Water bottle (labeled w/ child's full name)
- Bible
- Disposable camera (no real digital cameras)
- Flashlight
- Spending money (\$20-50) for Snack Shack/Gift Shop; quarters for pop machines, ping-pong balls and foos balls

Do NOT bring anything you are not willing to lose to theft – it happens!
Put camper names on everything! Call the Camp Office for any lost items. Found items are only held for two (2) weeks after camp.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Electronic devices of any kind (i.e. iPods, mp3 players, handheld game devices, etc.)
- Cell phones
- Alcohol or Tobacco
- Drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor)
- Firearms/Knives/Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks/Explosives/Lighters
- Prank materials (i.e. silly string, etc.)

DRESS CODE - MODESTY IS KEY

Girls

- No open midriffs
- Tank tops must have straps at least one inch wide
- Bra straps must be covered
- Shorts must be fingertip length or longer
- Dark shirt and shorts for water games
- Pajamas are not to be worn outside of cabins

Guys

- Underwear must be covered
- No "cut-up" t-shirts

CAMP NURSE

It is our desire to provide a fun, yet safe, environment for each camper. In order to accomplish this, a Registered Nurse is on-site and available 24 hours/day to assist with medical emergencies, first aid, and administration of medications. Please ensure that medical forms are filled out completely. **All camper's medications must be in their original containers, labeled with camper's name and clear instructions.** Medications should be placed in one labeled plastic bag per individual. These bags are turned into the nurse upon check-in.
