We're excited to think about returning to a public worship service. When we do, we want you to have every confidence that you can minimize your risk to infectious disease.

During the time since we've last met in our auditorium, we have taken steps to help you return to our church facilities with confidence. Here's some of what we have done:

- Deep cleaning and sanitizing of all our buildings.
- Reviewed and implemented best practices for leaders and volunteers regarding safe guidelines for social distancing.
- Placed more hand sanitizers in buildings.
- Identified safe distance areas in meeting rooms.
- Altered all meeting scheduling to ensure we can comply with social distancing guidelines.

### WE WANT YOU BACK!

Here's what you can do to return to public worship and Bible Study:

1. Choose which worship service time works best for your schedule. We will have two service options: 9:15 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. every Sunday until further notice.
2. Decide if you want to add a Bible Study hour to enhance your worship experience. We will provide two options for Adults and Students every Sunday: 9:15 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. Bible Study will meet in our Large Fellowship Hall and social distancing precautions have been made. If you have children, ages birth through 6<sup>th</sup> grade, children's ministries will be open for one or both hours between 9:15 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.
3. For those who are not yet ready to interact with others in our worship auditorium, we will continue to provide "live worship" at 10:45 a.m. at [www.FBCFO.com](http://www.FBCFO.com).
4. Help us stay in compliance with the social distancing guidelines by being respectful of people who want to remain at a distance when they attend. Be sure to avoid shaking hands, hugging, and touching other people. Also make sure to cover your mouth if you need to cough or sneeze (or cough or sneeze into your arm fold).
5. Be mindful of the church staff and volunteer workers by not getting too close or touching them.
6. We are trying to mitigate the risks involved in being around people during the covid-19 active season. There is no way we can completely remove the risk of being around other people. If you feel uncomfortable being around people at this time, it may be best to stay at home and join us for live online worship.
7. Be prepared to adapt to any changes that we will have to make to stay in compliance with guidelines given to us by our government leaders.

Thank you for being prepared to come back to our church facilities with confidence. We don't know when we will get the green light that says we can begin meeting, but when we do, we want to be prepared!
